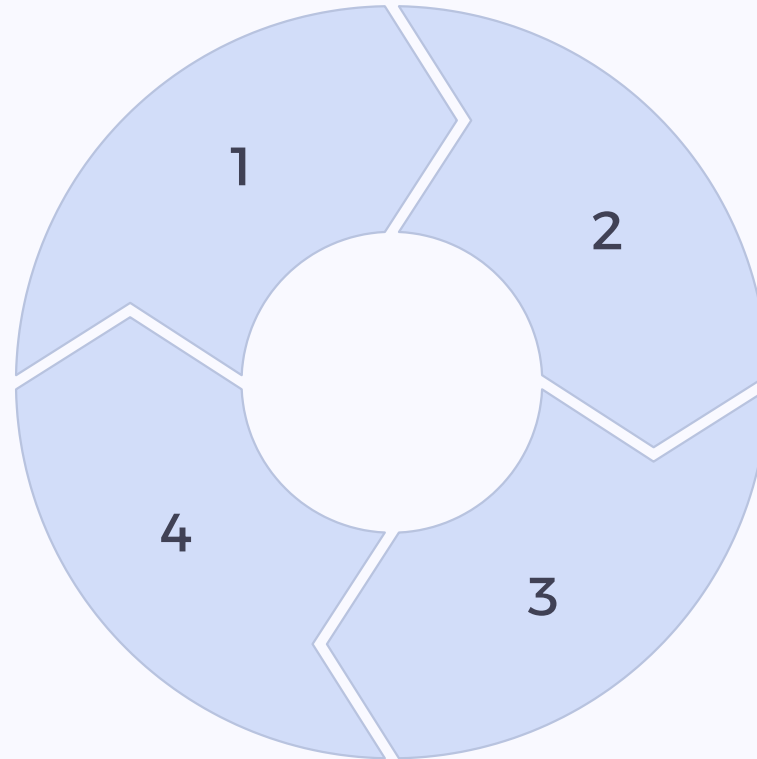
Inspire Belief
